The bus will be leaving from Wisconsin Street behind Maucker Union at 7:30 am and returning at approximately 6 pm. Total cost of the trip is \$73. This includes \$10 for transportation and \$63 for the skiing fee (includes: lift ticket, gear rental, and lesson). Lunch may be purchased on your own. Come to ISSO (Maucker Union 113) to sign up. Please bring exact change when signing up. This is a great opportunity to try your hand at skiing or snowboarding and to hang out with friends. This trip is for all international students, regardless of your level of ability. If you sign up before February 1, the resort will have your gear ready for you before you arrive. Anyone signing up after January 30 will need to fill out a rental form at the resort. Deadline to sign up is February 4.
