REVIEW OF THE 1947 SEASON

The Fighting Panthers in 1947 kept two victory streaks alive while capturing their fifth straight North Central conference title for a new record. Coach C. L. "Buck" Starbeck's eleven stretched the consecutive conference win string to 25 games. The Panthers also protected the home field victory streak which now stands at 16 games without a loss at O. R. Latham Stadium since 1941.

The Panthers were forced to share the North Central grid crown when South Dakota University also finished its loop play without a defeat. The two powerful elevens did not meet to decide the issue.

IOWA STATE TEACHERS COLLEGE FOOTBALL COACHING STAFF

CLYDE L. "BUCK" STARBECK - head grid coach and freshman basketball coach since 1936. His teams won four consecutive North Central conference titles in 1940, 1941, 1942, 1946, and 1947 establishing a record of 25 consecutive loop victories. Starbeck is starting his 13th season here after a great playing career at Montevideo, Minnesota, high school, Hamline University, Gonzaga University, and South Dakota State College. Coached at Pipestone, Minnesota, Indian School, Eau Claire, Wisconsin, High School (a state title), and the University of North Dakota, "Buck" graduated from South Dakota State in 1927, where he was all-conference center for three years.

OLIVER M. "HON" NORDLY - assistant football coach, head basketball and golf coach. A graduate of Red Wing, Minnesota, High School and Carleton College. Once rated as the outstanding high school coach in Minnesota. Nordly came to Teachers College in 1937. He coached basketball at Iowa Naval Pre-flight during the war.

DON BARNHART - assistant football coach, tutors the B squad. The newest member of the physical education staff assumed his duties last year. Barnhart, an all-conference tackle on Starbeck's championship teams of 1941, and 1942, coached in the Tipton public schools and at University high in Iowa City.

ARTHUR D. DICKINSON - football trainer - also head coach in track and cross country. Coached at Adair, Washington, Marshalltown High Schools before taking up at Teachers College. One of the nation's best track coaches, seldom missing the conference track title. "Dick's" teams have won 15 of 21 loop meets, and captured the North Central crown five times in ten years.

STADIUM INFORMATION

The \$110,000 Iowa State Teachers College Stadium is the biggest structure in the O. R. Latham Field. The stadium will seat 5,000 spectators in its 30 rows of 300 foot long seats. A permanent band "shell" seats the crack 125-piece Iowa State Teachers College entertaining band. The press box, which seats 80 newsmen, radio operators, and visiting dignitaries, is glass enclosed and is provided with adequate jacks for all wire and radio service. The stadium is constructed of concrete, steel, and brick. The electric scoreboard keeps all spectators completely up to date on time, down, and yardage to gain.

Night football is a reality at Iowa State Teachers College this year. Ninety-six sealbeam lights are used for illumination, 12 on each of the eight poles. Cost of the lighting system was about \$12,000. Two of the Panther home games are under the arc lights this year.

Rest Rooms will be found on the mezzanine floor. Locker rooms, drying rooms, equipment rooms, offices, training rooms, and a running track take up the space on the ground floor of the stadium.

TICKET INFORMATION

Season tickets will be \$6.00 with reserved seats for single games \$1.80. General admission prices are \$1.20 for adults, \$0.60 for high school students, and \$0.30 for grade school students. Kickoff time for afternoon games at Iowa State Teachers College is at 2:00 p.m. Night games start at 8:00 p.m.

All sports editors planning to attend Iowa State Teachers College football games, either as working press or as spectators, should send requests for GAME tickets to the Bureau of Publications. It will then only be necessary for you to stop at the office in the men's gymnasium the day of the game to secure the tickets. It is not the policy of the department to mail tickets.

When requesting GAME tickets please let us know if you want PRESS BOX tickets. The PRESS BOX ticket is for the working press only. It will be reserved for you with your GAME ticket.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The press box has radio facilities. If you are interested in service write the Bureau of Publications for further information.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

The Iowa State Teachers College is located in Cedar Falls, a city with a population of 10,000. Enrollment exceeds 2,800 (half Men). The college first opened its doors September 6, 1876, with one building and 27 students.

School colors are Royal Purple and Old Gold. Nickname for the athletic team is Panthers.

There are available this year four football practice fields in addition to the gridiron upon which all varsity and freshman games are contested.

This is the fiftieth football season at the Iowa State Teachers College. The game was first played on an intercollegiate basis in the fall of 1895 when Normal defeated Coe College, 12 to 10. During the 1906 and 1907 seasons the game was abolished. Also, during the war years 1943 and 1944.

The coaching staff of eight men has an average of tenure of better than 18 years per man. It is 28 years now for Mendenhall and Bender, the "original staff", 25 for Dickinson, 23 for Whitford, 19 for McCuskey, 13 for Starbeck, 12 for Nordly, and 4 for Barnhart.
