RETURNING PANTHER LETTERMEN

- ED AHRENS - Won a minor letter last year. Ahrens is returning for his second year of competition. He competed in the 175 pound bracket and won the state AAU heavyweight title in 1947.
- HAROLD BARD - Was a major letterwinner in 1946 when he alternated in the 136 pound class. Should see action in one of the lower weights. A sophomore from Clarion.
- DICK BLACK - Understudy of Bill Koll last year, Black should come into his own this season. A junior, he is a past winner of the state high school title, copping those laurels in 1940. He also won the state AAU crown in 1947.
- RUSS BUSH - Won the national title in the 128 class in 1947 and was runner-up in 1946 at 136 pounds. He captured the state AAU title in the 136½ pound class last year. The senior from Waterloo should be a standout in the lower weights again this year.
- JIM JENSEN - A letterwinner in the heavyweight class in 1947, Jensen should be a threat again this year. Although out of his class as a heavyweight, he is a tough competitor in the middle weights.
- LAVERN KLAR - A minor letterwinner last season. Klar is one of the leading candidates for the 128 pound post vacated by Gerald Leeman, the Olympic second place winner. He won all three of his matches last year, two of them by falls.
- BILL NELSON - Back for another year of terrorizing opponents. Nelson won the national title in 1947 but was unable to defend it because of injuries. He came back to win the No. 1 spot on the U. S. Olympic team. Nelson had to step down after being hurt in drills for the London games. He's back in shape now and should be tougher than ever. Scored 36 points last year.
- FLOYD OGLESBY - Another contender for Leeman's old spot. He won a minor letter in 1948, winning three out of four matches, two by falls. He and Klar should put on a great battle for the 128 pound post.
- BILL SMITH - Regular at 155 pounds last year. He was the third high scorer for the Panthers behind Bill Koll and Nelson with 22 points. Smith topped off the 1948 season by whipping Cornell's Rodger Snook.
- FRED STOEKER - Competed in the heavyweight class last year, winning a minor letter. He scored eight points. With the added experience, Stoeker should be tough this season.

DAVID H. MC CUSKEY, head wrestling coach at Iowa State Teachers college and secretary of the wrestling NCAA. Last year McCuskey piloted his matmen to eight victories in nine meets to stretch his won-lost record to 67 wins and only 28 defeats in 16 wrestling seasons. This mark has been made against the best teams in the country. Also Mc Cuskey led the Panthers to fourth place in the NCAA tournament. In 1946 and 1947, his team placed second. Eight times his proteges have walked off with national titles. He was graduated from Iowa State Teachers College in 1930 and that fall returned to his alma mater as mat coach. McCuskey was one of the greatest football players in Panther history, winning four letters as a triple-threat halfback. He was also a top-notch pitcher in baseball for three years. McCuskey is married and the father of two sons.
