OLIVER M. "HON" NORDLY, head basketball coach who is starting his tenth season at Iowa State Teachers. For the past two seasons, "Hon" has piloted the Panther cagers to the North Central conference crown, the college's first cage titles in the conference. Nordly also guided the Teachers golf team to the loop championship for the past two years. Panther teams coached by Nordly have won 48 conference games and lost only 28 since he took the reins in 1937. "Hon" was graduated from Carleton college where he won all-conference honors in football and basketball. Previous to that he was an all-round athlete at Red Wing, Minnesota, high school. Before coming to Teachers College, Nordly coached at Rochester, Minnesota, where he also turned out championship teams. In addition to coaching basketball and golf, "Hon" is football backfield coach and scouts gridiron opponents of the Panthers. His 1948-49 edition won 16 of 22 games to surpass the former record of 14 tilts won in a single season. The 1948-49 team also placed high in several departments of the small-college statistics section of the National Collegiate Athletic Bureau. During the war, Nordly coached at Iowa Pre-Flight school. He is married and the father of four children.

6'2, 175
Twice a letterman, Gisel is a senior. Played consistent ball last year and came through with points when needed. Can play either forward or guard. From Ventura.
- FRED HAVEMANN
5'9, 180
Reserve guard last year. A junior from Muscatine. Should be a leading candidate for a regular position this winter. Played on Panther grid team this fall.
- NORM JESPERSEN
6'4, 180
Has broken the school scoring record twice. "Jess" holds the Teachers College mark in field goals, 132, total points, 349, offensive average, 15.9, in addition to free throw record of 94 set two years ago. All-conference forward for the past two seasons. A senior from Cedar Falls.
- WALT KOCHNEFF
6'2, 190
Playing his third season for the Panthers. Named to all-conference team twice. Small for a center but excels as a play-maker. Scored 280 points last year. A senior from Muscatine.
- JIM LUDEMAN
6'6, 185
Came along fast near the end of last season, showing deadly accuracy from the corners. Could be a great asset with his height and basket eye. A senior from Waukon.
- CHARLES RIEK
6'2, 160
Starting his fourth year on the Panther varsity. A senior from Muscatine, he is the club's defensive ace. Can score when necessary. Should be a fixture at guard.

RETURNING PANTHER LETTERMEN

LOWELL COOK - Won a minor letter last year, appearing in one varsity meet and most of the "B" squad duals. A contender in the lower weights.

JOHN HARRISON - Walked off with the National AAU 121 pound crown last year as a freshman. Was third in team scoring with 30 points with three falls and five decisions in nine meets. Also won State AAU title.

LUVERNE KLAR - Veteran who wrapped up the 128 pound position for the Panthers last year. He tallied one fall, five decisions and one draw in nine meets against some of the toughest competition. Also captured third in the National Collegiate at 136 pounds.

MAX LONG - Won a minor letter last year for his work in "B" squad meets. A rough and tumble matman at 155 pounds.

BILL NELSON - Reliable Bill is one of the top wrestlers in the country. Won the NCAA 165 pound title as a freshman but had to default in his sophomore year because of injuries. Came back to win the top spot in the U. S. Olympic team but again had to withdraw because of injuries. Last year he walked off with both NCAA and National AAU 155 pound crowns. Was the Panthers' leading scorer in dual meets with four falls and five decisions in nine meets. A senior.

FLOYD OGLESBY - Captured five victories in six meets last year before being injured. Should be the top contender for the 136 pound spot on the basis of his performances last year. A senior from Mason City.

BILL SMITH - As a sophomore, Bill claimed both the NCAA and National AAU individual 165 pound titles last year. Is still undefeated in college meets although tied once last year and once the previous season. Usually wrestles at 175.

FRED STOEKER - Regular heavyweight last year. Now in his third season, Fred should be mighty rugged with the extra experience. Showed flashes of brilliance in 1949. A senior, he had never wrestled until two years ago.

KEITH YOUNG - Third of the Panthers' double winners last year, taking NCAA and National AAU titles at 145 pounds. Placed second in team scoring in dual meets with two falls and seven decisions in nine tries. A junior this year, he learned his wrestling the hard way, as a sparmate for Bill Koll in 1948. Undefeated in college dual meets.

Although not a letterman, GENE LYBBERT rates some mention here for his work in the National AAU tourney last year. As a freshman, Lybbert placed second to John Harrison in the 121 pound class.

DAVID H. MC CUSKEY, head wrestling coach at Iowa State Teachers College, has piloted his grapplers to 76 wins and only 28 defeats in 17 wrestling seasons. In 1949, his Panther matmen won nine dual meet victories, placed first in the State AAU meet, won second in the national collegiate, and captured the National AAU tourney. His teams have placed second in the NCAA in 1946, 1947 and 1949 and fourth in 1948. He has made the Panther campus virtually a home of mat champions, especially since the war. Eleven times, ten since 1936, his proteges have won NCAA titles. In addition, five won National AAU titles and three won the U. S. Olympic tryouts. One of these captured the second place silver medal in the Olympics. McCuskey was graduated from Iowa State Teachers College in 1930. That fall he returned to his alma mater as wrestling coach. In his undergraduate days, McCuskey was one of the greatest football players in Panther history, winning four letters as a triple-threat halfback. He was also a top-notch baseball pitcher for three years but "wasn't quite good enough to make the wrestling team!" McCuskey is married and the father of two sons.
