Simple Playdough for One



3 small cups	salt & flour mix
1 big cup	water
1 big spoon	oil

Mix together in paper cup and cook in electric skillet.



small cup=1/4 cup big cup=1/2 cup big spoon=1 TBSP

For one you will need:

3/4 cup salt & flour mix (1/2 cup flour + 1/4 cup salt + 1 teaspoon cream of tartar + 1 package dry Kool-aid) 1/2 cup water 1 Tablespoon oil

Mix together in oiled electric skillet and cook until play dough begins to dry around the edges and pull away from pan.

Playdough for a crowd:

6 cups flour 3 cups salt 12 teaspoons cream of tartar 6 packages Kool-aid
