Fifty Chips Cover Up

Materials: *Fifty Chips* Cover Up board (one per player), a die, 50 chips/tokens per player

Objectives: Be the first player to fill all fifty spaces on your board.

To Play:

- 1. Players each take one game board and 50 chips.
- 2. Players decide who will go first.
- 3. Players take turns rolling the die and putting that number of chips on their board.
- 4. The game ends when every space on one player's board is covered. That player is the winner.
