

Just a friendly reminder about the fair use while using the equipment in the Rod Library. Fair use indicates that you can make: One copy of one article per issue of a periodical. One copy of one chapter per book if the book is divided into chapters, or one copy of 10% of the book if it is not divided into chapters. One copy of 10% of a piece of music. One copy of one poem per book, up to 250 lines. One copy of no more than two pages from a

One copy of no more than two pages from a children's book.
