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

After 2020-2021 the decision was made to *re-launch and combine models* to form the **lowa Science Learning Community**.


Iowa Science Learning Community (ISLC) - Who are we?

Problems of Practice for the ISLC

Year 1: How can we encourage student discourse using both social-emotional learning and science sensemaking?

Year 2: How can actionable feedback help with student sensemaking?

Year 3: How can we enhance student engagement in the science classroom?

Year 4: How can we collect and use evidence of student learning?



Setting the Stage

Reflection/Partner Talk

Compass Points Thinking Routine*

- **E = Excited:** What excites you so far about this idea/process? What's the upside?
- <u>W = Worrisome:</u> What do you find worrisome so far about this idea/process? What's the downside?
- N = Need to Know: What else do you need to know or find out about this idea/process? What additional information would help you to evaluate things or apply it to your role?
- **S = Stance for Moving Forward:** What is your current stance or opinion about this idea/process?

Coaching Role Breakout Conversation




Reflection/Partner Talk

Connect, Extend, Challenge Thinking Routine*

- How did the ideas and information presented connect to what you already know?
- What did you see/hear that broadened your thinking or extended it in different directions?
- What challenges or puzzles emerged for you?


