# **International Bank Payments Using peerTransfer**

The University of Northern Iowa has partnered with peerTransfer for a more cost-effective method for international students to wire funds from their home country bank to the university. Students will be offered excellent exchange rates allowing them to pay in their home country's currency (in most cases) and save a significant amount of money compared to traditional bank wire costs. The posting of your payment to the University will be faster, students will have the ability to track their payment and peerTransfer will notify students when the University has received their payment.
