INCOME TAX FEEDBACK REQUEST

As announced earlier this semester, Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) will not be available for international students this season due to technology and training problems. Students may be eligible to file returns using Free File, available from the U.S. Internal Revenue Service (IRS) at www.irs.gov. You may also hire the services of a tax preparation or accounting firm of your choice. We would like to collect information about what you, our students, have been doing to meet your tax filing obligations. If you have filed your 2011 tax return, we invite you to reply to this message and let us know how you chose to do so: By filing yourself, using Fee File, a tax preparation service or some other way. We want to be able to share this information with students who are still not certain about how to handle their taxes this season.

Just a reminder: If you did not have a job in 2011, you should still file IRS form 8843, available here: $\frac{\text{http://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/f8843.pdf}}{\text{possible part I}}$ You will only need to complete Part I and Part III before signing at the bottom of the form and sending it to the IRS at the address indicated in the instructions.

April 15, 2012 is the deadline for filing all 2011 tax returns!
