GUEST CONDUCTORS

Erin Holmes launched her career at the beginning of the millennium by attaining a teaching position for Farmington Area Public Schools, District 192. As the Director of Bands at Farmington High School, Ms. Holmes conducts the Wind Ensemble, Varsity Band, Jazz I, Birdland Jazz, and is the head director of the Farmington Tiger Marching Band. Her ensembles have made appearances on the Dave Ryan in the Morning show on KDWB, and as KSTP's High School Band on Sports Wrap. She has a host of responsibilities at Farmington High School that range from planning tours for her bands, hosting band festivals attending jazz festivals with her ensembles, to being a devoted staff and team member of several building leadership positions such as a Mentor for new teachers, and the FHS Music Department Chair. Ms. Holmes's jazz ensembles have appeared in many prestigious festivals and honor bands.

In 2017, School Band and Orchestra Magazine named Holmes one of the nation's "50 Directors Who Make a Difference." When asked what is your proudest moment as an educator? She responds, "My proudest moment as an educator has yet to come. Each day brings a new experience that challenges my mindset, intellect, and emotions on such a wide-ranging scale. Each year has also brought my own expertise to new levels. To try and define my pride of what we have created here in Farmington to one moment just isn't possible." Her favorite phrase she lives by and attempts to instill in her students is "every day is a good day to get better."

Most notably to her career, she has been appointed as the Jazz Chair for Minnesota Music Educators Association (MMEA) in 2018, she is the first woman in the organization's history to be chosen for this position.

Dr. Bradley P. Ethington is Director of Bands and Professor of Music at Syracuse University, where he conducts the University Wind Ensemble, coordinates the graduate program in wind conducting, and serves as chair of wind and percussion studies. Dr. Ethington holds bachelor's degrees in Music Education and Biochemistry from the Honors College at Michigan State University, the Master of Music from Baylor University, and the Doctor of Musical Arts in Conducting from The University of Texas at Austin. While at the University of Texas, he served as assistant conductor of the University Wind Ensemble and conductor of the University Chamber Orchestra.

Dr. Ethington has published articles in the journals of the College Band Directors National Association and the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles on the wind music of W. A. Mozart and Charles Ives, and has been a regular contributor to the highly successful educational series, Teaching Music Through Performance in Band. Dr. Ethington is an elected member of the prestigious American Bandmasters Association, and Past President of the Big East Conference Band Directors Association. He has appeared as guest conductor at conferences of the College Band Directors National Association, the World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles, and the New York State School Music Association, and this summer he will guest conduct the Orchestre d'Harmonie of the Conservatoire de Strasbourg in France. Dr. Ethington has served as guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator throughout the United States, Europe, Southeast Asia, and Australia.

Professor **Fergus O'Carroll** was born in Waterford into a musical family. He studied French Horn with Victor Malirsh at the Royal Irish Academy of Music under a scholarship from the Irish Youth Orchestra and is currently Section Principal Horn with the National Symphony Orchestra of Ireland. Fergus holds a Masters Degree in Music from CIT Cork School of Music.

As well as being Musical Director of the award winning Dublin Concert Band, Fergus is also Musical Director of Mullingar Choral Society and Director of the Junior and Senior Wind Bands at the Royal Irish Academy of Music where he also teaches French Horn. He has appeared on many occasions as guest conductor with the RTÉ National Symphony and Concert Orchestras and has also conducted the Orchestra of St Cecilia, the Dublin Baroque Players and many other community institutions.

Fergus was Chairperson of the Local Organizing Committee that hosted the much acclaimed World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles World Conference in Ireland in July, 2007 and is a publisher of Irish wind band music. As a composer, he has had many of his compositions and arrangements performed and recorded by leading ensembles and he is recognized nationally as a specialist in the field of music notation.

After a long career as a professional horn player with RTÉ, Fergus retired in 2016 as Acting Section Leader French Horn with the National Symphony Orchestra and shortly thereafter he became Head of Faculty, Woodwind Brass and Percussion, at the Royal Irish Academy of Music.
