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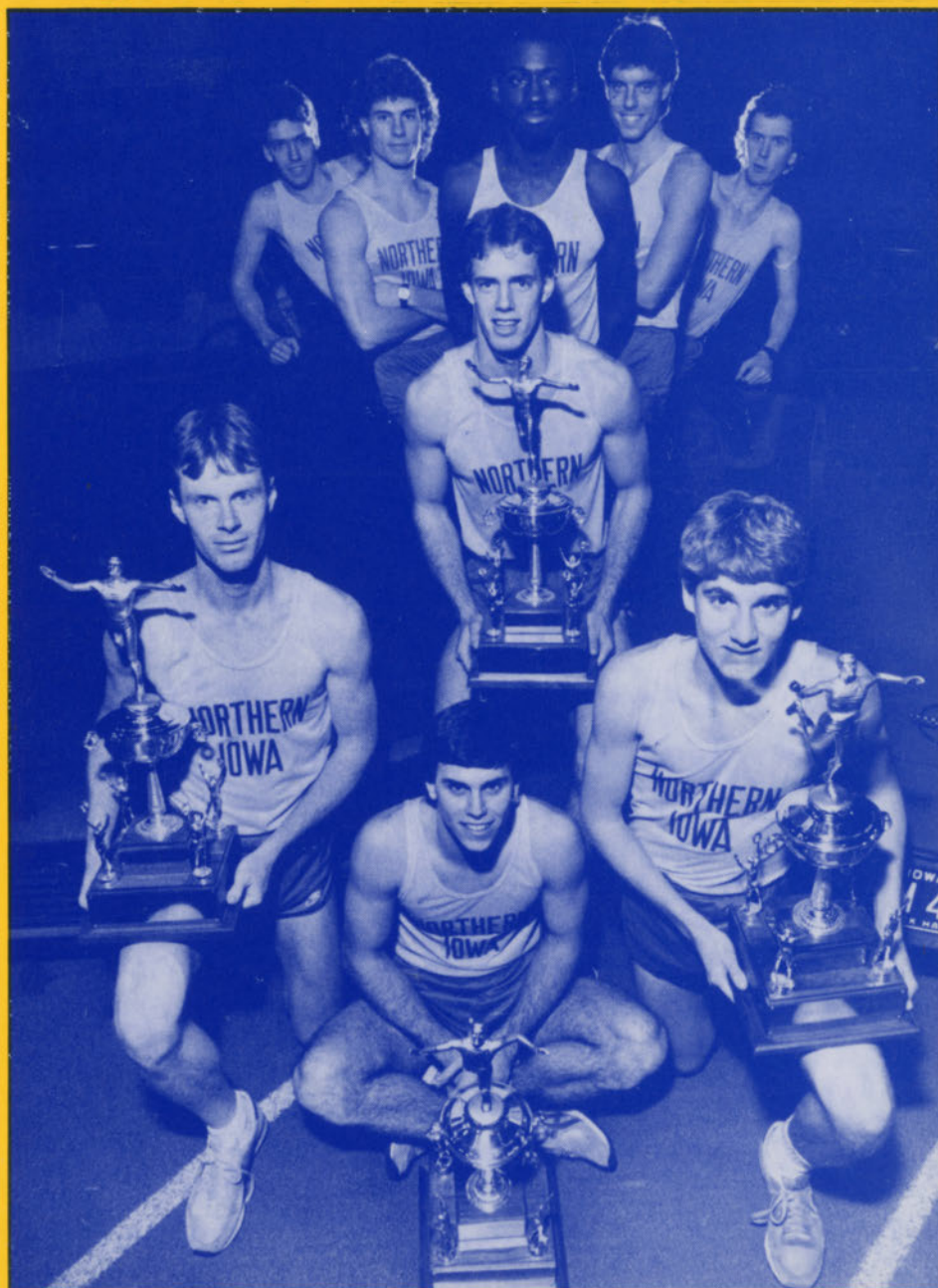

The Panthers have been "exceeding the limits" in recent years, dominating the Association of Mid-Continent Universities (AMCU) and rewriting the UNI record books. The UNI men have now won or shared the last *seven* consecutive Mid-Continent league titles over the past three seasons, including three cross country championships, three outdoor track championships, and the first indoor track championships held last year.

Over the course of those three years, the Panthers have virtually rewritten the school record books with 12 new UNI indoor track records, four new UNI-Dome records, 10 new UNI outdoor track records, and 10 new UNI freshmen records.

1985 UNI Track and Field Outlook

The 1985 Panthers will be looking to continue their recent dominance in Association of Mid-Continent Universities (AMCU) action as they defend their indoor and outdoor track championships this season. In November, Northern Iowa tied for the AMCU cross country title with Southwest Missouri, marking the third straight year the Panthers had won or shared the fall championship. Including indoor and outdoor track along with cross country, the Panthers have brought home seven consecutive Mid-Continent championship trophies.

First-year UNI head coach Chris Bucknam, who served for five seasons as an assistant to former UNI track coach Lynn King, has a strong squad of returnees on hand to vie for the AMCU titles again. Eleven seniors are on the UNI roster this season.

The Panthers' long distance corps will be led by three AMCU all-conference cross country honorees — Chris Leonard, Dan Fick, and Todd Goodell. The UNI squad also returns three AMCU track champions — Russ Adams in the pole vault and decathlon (1983), John Place in the decathlon (1984), and Steve Weaver in the high jump.

The UNI tracksters will miss four senior AMCU champions from a year ago — Steve Muntz (880-yard run), Jay Connor (60-yard high hurdles), Matt Haven (discus), and Kirk Anderson (800 meters).

However, the Panthers appear to be a very deep squad talent-wise as they also return 10 AMCU track and field runners-up from last year, including Steve Gearhart (steeplechase), Dan Fick (10,000 meters and two-mile run), Scott Sloan (javelin), Troy Becker (pole vault), Jim Kindig (high jump), Doug Case (100 meters), Solomon Anderson (600-yard dash), Brian Glassmaker (mile run), Joe Fuller (60-yard dash), and Paul Egger (1,000-yard run).

Selected as UNI indoor team captains this season were Glassmaker, Gearhart, Becker, Adams, and Fick, and outdoor team captains are Gearhart, Glassmaker, Becker, Adams, and Anderson.

Bucknam is optimistic about the Panthers' 1985 squad. "We've got some really fine front-line athletes," the UNI coach said. "There are a few areas that concern me, mainly the throws, depthwise. We'll just have to cover ourselves in the areas where we're strong — middle distance and sprints."

The Panthers should again be challenged strongly by Eastern Illinois and Southwest Missouri in this year's AMCU meets. "Eastern Illinois and Southwest Missouri are coming on strong, and Western Illinois had a good recruiting year," Bucknam commented. "We've basically got a senior-led team, but when the AMCU teams come into the Dome, it will be a dog fight." The UNI men host the AMCU indoor championships March 1-2 in the UNI-Dome, while this spring's outdoor conference meet will be held at Eastern Illinois.

"I would like to get as many of our athletes to approach national standards as possible," Bucknam said. "If we can do that, we will be a viable Division I program in any conference. There's no question that Lynn King has a tremendous amount to do with the success we've enjoyed over the past few years, and I want to continue to improve our showing in the conference."

The first-year UNI head coach is aided by new assistant coach Bill Lawson, a former four-time UNI All-American decathlete. "I think our coaching staff is very strong," Bucknam said. "With Bill Lawson, a former All-American decathlete, there's a tremendous amount of knowledge that our athletes can benefit from."

UNI Panthers Coaching Staff

Head Coach Chris Bucknam

Chris Bucknam, assistant men's track and field coach at Northern Iowa for the past five years, was named the Panthers' new head coach last August, replacing Lynn King who resigned to become UNI assistant athletic director.

Bucknam was UNI's first full-time assistant and coached primarily the sprinters for King. Bucknam has been involved in coaching two athletes who were finalists at the Kansas Relays, Drake Relays, and Domino Pizza Relays in Florida — Jay Connor and Doug Case, both UNI school recordholders. He also has coached athletes over the past five years who have broken seven indoor and three outdoor school records. His list of accomplishments includes coaching 16 conference champions, and the Panthers won six straight league titles during his tenure as an assistant.

"I feel very honored that I have been included in the coaching ranks along with A.D. Dickinson, Jack Jennett, and Lynn King, all who have had outstanding coaching careers at UNI," Bucknam said. "I have inherited a very strong program — one which is in excellent shape. We, of course, will try to continue the success, not only at the conference level, but regionally, also. We have athletes now who are national contenders."

"We have a talented team, and the upperclassmen will provide good leadership," Bucknam commented.

A native of Beverly, MA, Bucknam attended Norwich University in Northfield, VT, where he was a four-time letterwinner in track, specializing in the middle and long distance events. He was elected co-captain his senior year and graduated from Norwich in 1978 with a bachelor's degree in physical education. He earned a master's degree in physical education in 1982 from UNI.

Bucknam and his wife, Cindy, reside in Cedar Falls.

Assistant Coach Bill Lawson

Bill Lawson, former four-time Northern Iowa All-American decathlete, was named the Panthers' new full-time assistant men's track and field coach this fall.

Lawson, a 1980 UNI graduate, was in his senior year with the Panthers when Chris Bucknam was named as the school's first full-time track assistant in 1979. A UNI school record-holder in the triple jump and decathlon, Lawson was a two-time co-captain for the Panthers. The Carthage, IL, native qualified for national competition in the decathlon, pole vault, and triple jump for four years.

Lawson returns to the Panthers after serving three years as boys' track, girls' cross country, and girls' basketball coach at John Marshall High School in Rochester, MN. His specific duties at UNI will include coordinating the Panthers' fall track program and conditioning and coaching the field events and decathlon during the indoor and outdoor track seasons. He will also serve as faculty advisor for the I-Club, an organization for all former UNI letterwinners in men's and women's sports, and he will teach in the physical education department at UNI.

"I am very excited about the opportunity to be in a Division I program and learn more about the administration of it," commented Lawson. "One of the nice things is that having run in this program myself under Bucknam will make me more familiar with the coaching philosophy here."

King Named UNI Assistant AD



After coaching the UNI men's cross country and track teams for nine seasons, the Panthers' head coach Lynn King resigned last June to become UNI's new assistant athletic director-facilities.

King had led the Panthers to 11 conference team championships, produced 122 individual conference champions and 25 All-Americans (including two national champions), and received league coach of the year honors 11 times. He was only the third head men's track coach ever at UNI. King had previously served as head coach at Rochester Community College (MN) for four years.

King graduated from UNI in 1969 with a bachelor's degree in physical education and received his master's degree from UNI in 1971.

"I have enjoyed my tenure here at UNI as both athlete and coach," King said, "and I view my new job as another way of contributing to the University and athletic program. This is an exciting time for UNI athletics and I'm pleased I can continue my association with it."

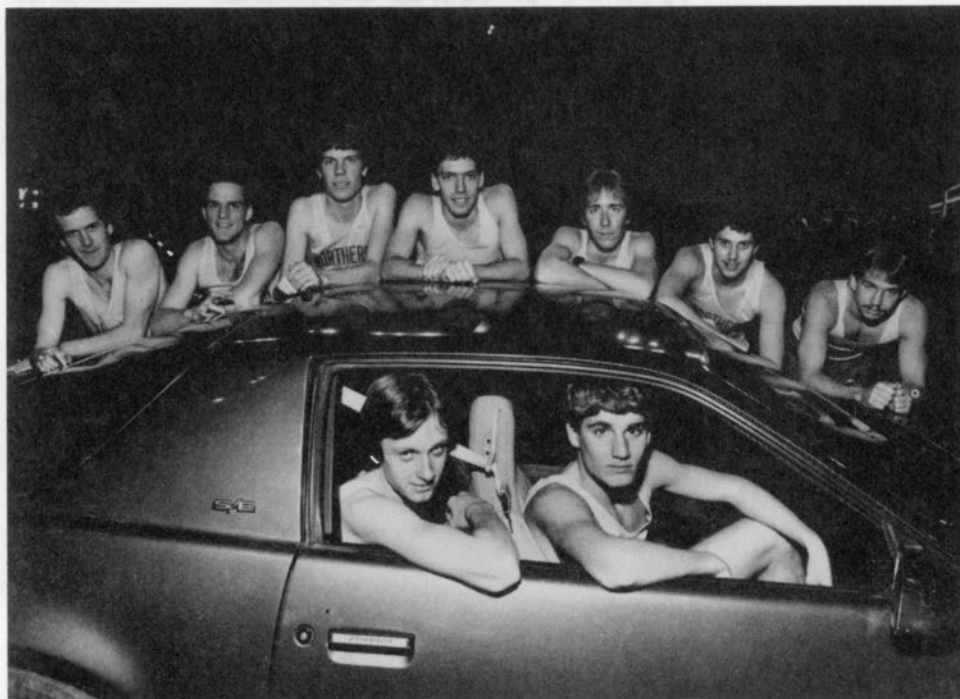

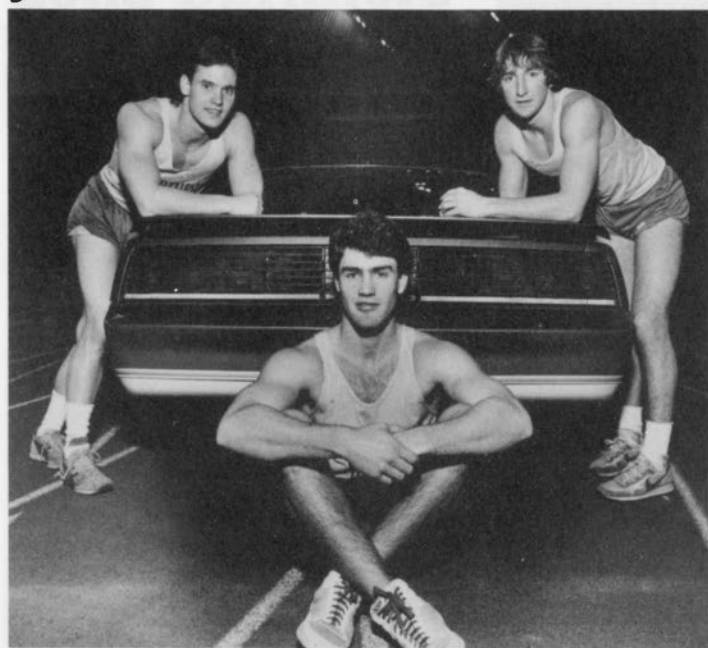

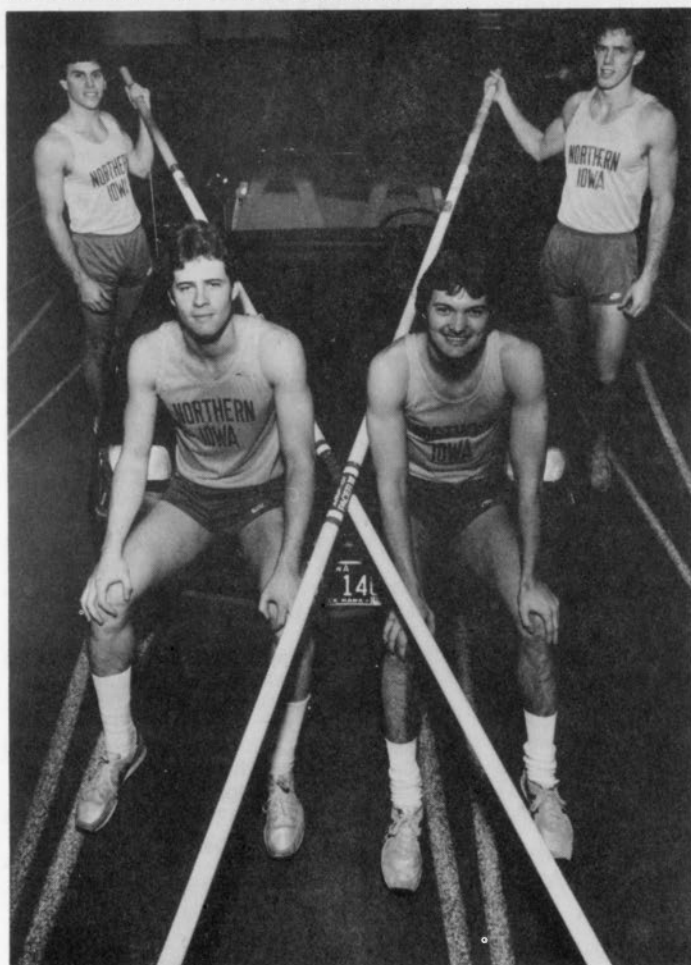

The UNI-Dome

One of America's Premier Indoor Facilities

UNI supporters and the entire State of Iowa realized a dream come true with the completion of the UNI-Dome — a completely covered, multi-purpose facility with an air-supported roof — in February of 1975.

UNI-Dome, the prefix standing for the University of Northern Iowa, as well as meaning unique, combines the features of three buildings — a football stadium, fieldhouse and large auditorium. It hosts such events as concerts, exhibitions, trade shows, pageants, rallies and convocations, as well as football, basketball, and softball games and wrestling and track meets.

Multi-Purpose Use

The UNI-Dome was designed with "something for everyone." Its artificial turf for football games and practices can be rolled up in 45 minutes. Underneath, on a synthetic floor area, are basketball and tennis courts and an eight-lane, 220-yard oval running track. As many as 12 tennis matches and two basketball games can take place simultaneously at the field level.

Approximately 16,400 spectators can be seated for football and 8,500 for court-side activities. For stage activities, such as commencement, concerts and artist or speaker series, total capacity — using movable bleachers and folding chairs — can reach 25,000.

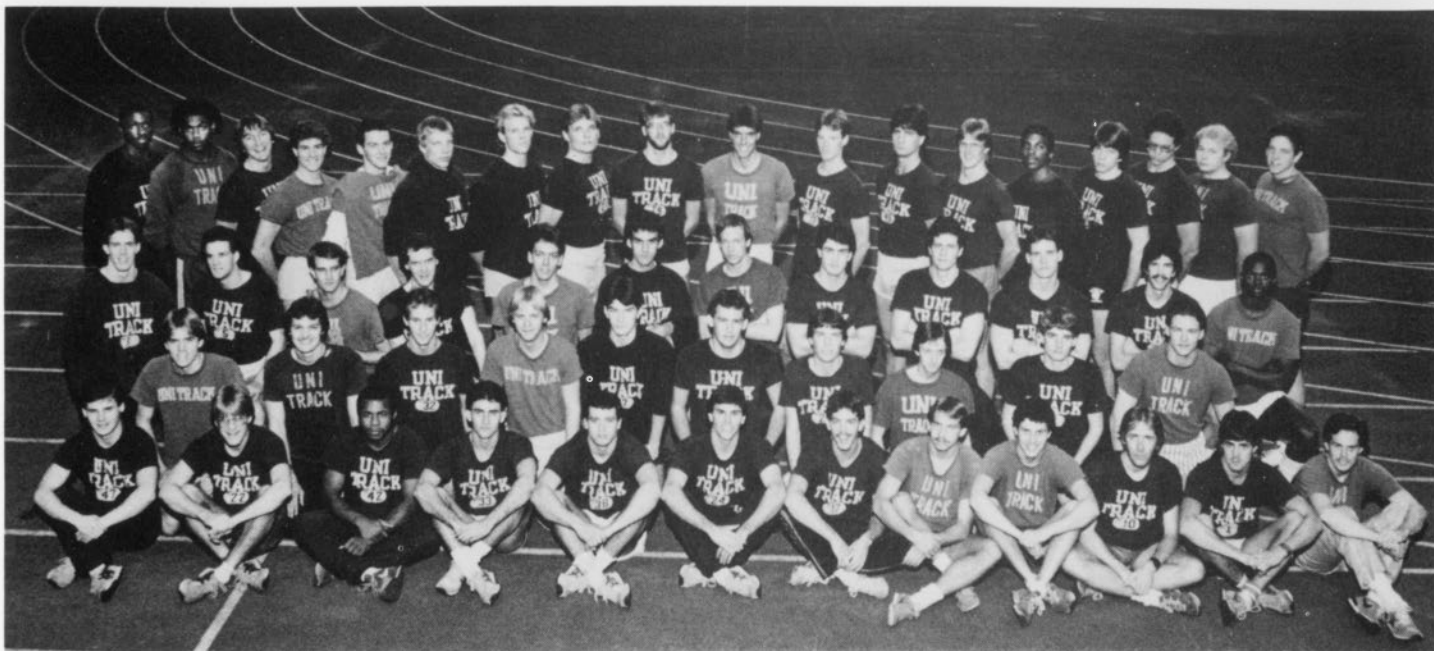

Each Running Mate is scheduled to work at a practice two or three times a week taking times, making sure each athlete completes his workout as well as other basic practice duties which allows Bucknam and Bill Lawson to work on a more individualized basis with the athletes. During meets, the group times races, runs all field events, and gives the awards to the competitors. They alternate working in the track office and are responsible for some correspondence, handling phone calls, meet preparation, and various recruiting duties.

The Running Mates also help with fund-raising events and participate in various social events with each other and the members of the track squad. Picnics, parties and other activities help the organization get to know each other as well as the UNI track team members on a more informal basis.
