ADMISSION OF NEW STUDENTS

The application for admission, high school credits, and transcripts of credit earned in other colleges must be in the Office of the Registrar before an admission card can be issued. If you have never received your admission card, or have lost it, report to the Registrar's Office for permission to register.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE Monday, December 5, 1955, 8:00 to 5:00 p. m.

This registration period is for all students who did not register November 16.

1. Men begin registration at the office of the Dean of Students; women at the office of the Associate Dean of Students.
2. Present materials received at the Deans' offices to the Registrar's clerk in the corridor between Gilchrist and Administration Buildings. Fill out all forms received here. If you are a veteran, go to the veterans station in the Registrar's office. All new-student veterans must file certified copy, D. D. 214 with the veterans' clerk whether under G. I. or not.
3. If you are a new student, have your picture taken at the Audio-Visual Center, Administration Building, second floor.
4. Pay your fees to the Business Office representative down stairs (first floor).
5. Take your cards to your adviser and arrange with him your schedule.
6. If you are to do student teaching, get your assignment near the Curriculum Lab., Administration Building.
7. When your adviser has approved your schedule, go to the basement of the Administration Building and complete your registration.
Note: New students will go first to the north end of the basement corridor to have their speech check (Room 41).

ADVANCE REGISTRATION FOR FORMER STUDENTS AND GRADUATE STUDENTS Wednesday, November 16, 1955.

If you have not already received your teaching assignment, it will be made during the registration process, second floor Administration Building near the curriculum Lab.

This registration period is for students who are on the campus during fall quarter or who have previously been in attendance and for graduate students. However, students whose registrations for fall quarter have not been cleared may not register at this time.

Men who live on campus will start at their dormitories. Men living off-campus will start at the office of the Dean of Students. All women students will start at the office of the Faculty Room.

Students will pass down the corridor between Gilchrist and Administration Buildings; men on 3rd floor, women on 2nd floor. Veterans enrolling for the first time under a V. A. program at MSTC must report to the Veteran's Clerk in the Registrar's office before passing the fee collection table. All veterans whether under V. A. program or not must have a certified copy of D. D. 214 or file in the Registrar's office.

Fees will be paid on the first floor of the Administration Building.

Get your home and college address cards in the corridor near the cross roads.

Registration will be completed in the Women's Gymnasium, where advisers will be located.

EVENING CLASSES

Evening classes are scheduled to begin Monday, December 5 or Wednesday, December 7. All evening classes will meet at 7:00 p. m.

If at all possible, students intending to attend these classes should register at one of the regular registration periods, November 16 or December 5. Those who cannot do so may register at the Office of the Registrar, Room 10, Administration Building, during the hour preceding the first meeting of the class: 6:00-7:00 p. m. December 5 or 7.

SATURDAY CLASSES

Saturday classes are scheduled to begin Saturday, December 10. Students who plan to enroll for them should if at all possible register November 16 or December 5. Those who find it impossible to do may register at the Office of the Registrar, Room 10, Administration Building on Saturday, December 10. The office will be kept open from 8:00 to 9:00 a. m. for this purpose.

LATE REGISTRATION

If you must register late, consult with the Dean of Faculty to learn whether registration will be permitted, and, if so, under what conditions. The Registrar's Office will inform you about the procedure to follow in registering. A fee of \$2.00 is charged for late registration.

CHANGE OF REGISTRATION

No course for credit may be added after 4:50 p. m. on Monday, December 19, 1955.

Until 4:50 p. m., Friday, January 13, 1956 a fee of \$1.00 will be charged for any change of registration not required by the college.

Courses dropped after 4:50 p. m., Friday, January 13, 1956 will be recorded with a mark of WP or WF.

No course may be dropped after 4:50 p. m., Friday, February 17, 1956.

If you desire a change in your registration, follow this procedure:

1. Consult with your adviser about the proposed change. If he approves the change, he will fill out and sign a change-of-registration card.
2. Bring the change card at once to the Registrar's Office for checking. When cleared present it at Room 10, basement Administration Building.

STUDENT LOAD

17 hours limit, unless student has above 2.50 grade point index (PE 01 included)

18 hours limit, unless student has above 3.00 grade point index. (PE 01 included)

20 hours limit, no exceptions. (PE 01 included)

First quarter enrollees are limited to 17 hours including PE 01.

EXPLANATION OF COURSE NUMBERS

Courses with 0 prefixed, open to students in any year of residence.

Courses 1-9 open to freshmen only.

Courses 10-99 open to freshmen and sophomores.

Courses 100-199 open to freshmen, sophomores and juniors.

Courses 200-299 open to sophomores and juniors.

Courses 300-399 open to sophomores, juniors and seniors.

Courses 400-499 open to juniors and seniors.

Courses 500-599 open to juniors, seniors and graduates.

Courses 600-699 open to graduates only.

CLASSIFICATION

Freshmen are students with 47 hours or less.

Sophomores are students with 48-95 hours.

Juniors are students with 96-143 hours.

Seniors are students with 144 hours or more.
