


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Survey Highlights

Over 75% of graduates were employed following graduation, and

almost 20% of graduates were headed to graduate or professional school.

Top five skills graduates said they were best prepared to utilize after graduation

- (1) Learning new things
- (2) Working independently
- (3) Conducting themselves in a professional manner
- (4) Making decisions
- (5) Defining and solving problems

Almost 90% of graduates said they would recommend UNI or recommend their major to a prospective student.

Over 90% of graduates participated in at least one leadership or enhanced learning opportunity during their time at UNI.

Methodology


Fall 2022 Administration

The initial invitation was sent in early November to 688 undergraduate students who had applied for Fall 2022 graduation. Out of the 688 possible respondents, 308 surveys were completed with a 44.8% response rate


Spring 2023 Administration


The initial invitation was sent in early April to 1,264 undergraduate students who had applied for spring or summer graduation. Out of the 1,264 possible respondents, 467 surveys were completed with a 36.9% response rate


The overall response rate for this survey was 39.7% with 775 total respondents.




Respondent Demographics










Plans After Graduation


