As this issue of *ISTJ* goes to press, word has been received that Dr. Robert W. Hanson has died. It is with deep regret that we learn of his passing and the brevity of his Minnesota retirement. He is remembered for his many years of dedicated service to the Iowa Academy of Science, particularly as Executive Director and Managing Editor of *ISTJ*. For 21 years he served as Professor of Chemistry and Science Education at the University of Northern Iowa, retiring in Spring 1985 due to illness.
