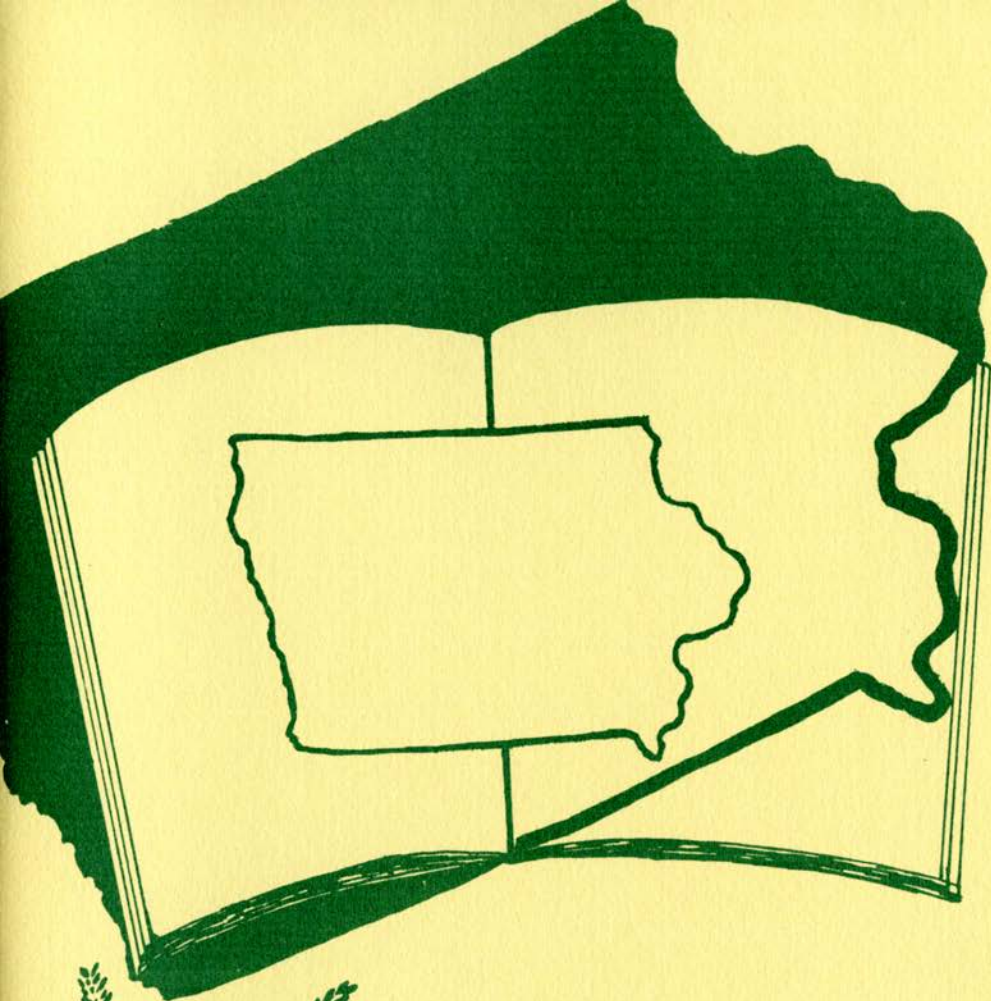

Publications will be received from all individuals interested in science education at any academic level. Preferential treatment will be given to Academy members and to papers with topics of special scientific and educational interest to science educators in Iowa.

All non-solicited manuscripts submitted to the editor will be reviewed by two authorities in the area concerned. All manuscripts must be typewritten, double-spaced on one side of a sheet and submitted in duplicate. Every attempt will be made to publish papers within a year after approval for publication. News items will be published promptly. Publication deadlines are April, September and December.
