## Notes on Fleishy Fungi in Iowa. IV<sup>1</sup>

*Abstract.* Sixty-six sporocarps of fleshy fungi were collected during the summer and fall of 1965. Two species not previously reported for the state of Iowa were collected, *Amanita peckiana* Kauf, and *Lectarius affinis* Pk.

During the last three years sporocarps of fleshy fungi were collected from six sites in Iowa (1,2,3). From the collection of 66 sporocarps from these sites during the summer and fall of 1965 two species that have not been reported previously in Iowa were found. Other reports of fleshy fungi in Iowa are noted (1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9).

Kauffman (10) was the identification reference for both collections.

*Amanita peckiana* Kauf. Several specimens were collected at Site 4 on 16 July. The volva, veil, and annulus were present but the annulus had deteriorated to a certain extent.

*Lectarius affinis* Pk. One specimen was collected at Site 5 on 16 July. This sporocarp seemed fairly old and yellowed.
