322 263 Report of the Ad Hoc Committee on Grade Inflation (circulated to Senate members in calendar item 322 and with the announcement to 1982-83 senators of the first Senate meeting; distributed to the UNI faculty with a cover letter dated 22 September 1982).

325 266 Request from United Student Association for Senate Action on Office transfer of Harold Burris, and for Attention to Affirmative Action Procedures at UNI. (Senate moved--see Minutes 1304--to consider Affirmative Action procedures without necessarily relating that issue to the Burris office transfer.) See Appendix A of Minutes 1304.

Senator Duea has informed the Senate Chair that when this docket item comes before the Senate, her intention is to move, as an initial step, that the Senate request from the Affirmative Action Committee at the earliest possible date the committee's evaluation of the present status of the Affirmative Action Program at UNI, and of possible future directions of that program.
