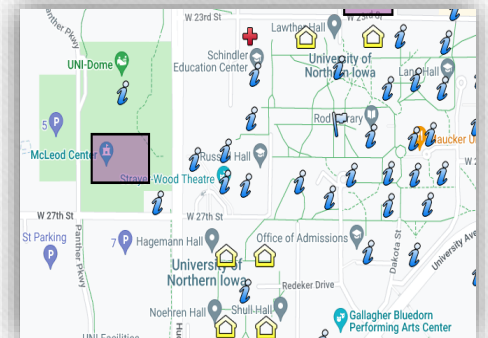

- Links to the UNI Strategic Plan

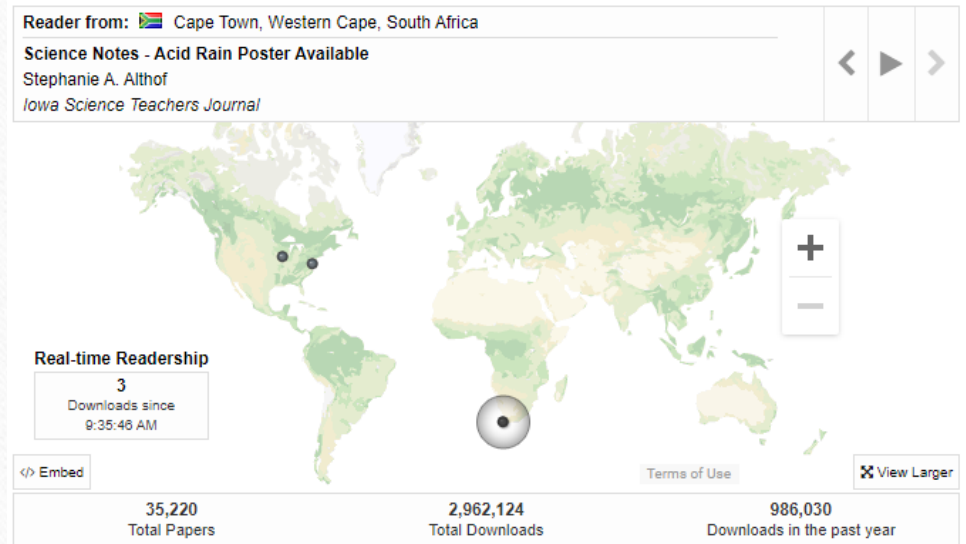

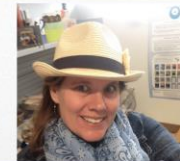
- First time a library sponsored newsletter distributed by the Provost Office
