This is, high-integrity writing to compare with the likes of Bob Brookmeyer, Thad Jones, Kenny Werner, Maria Schneider, Toshiko, and others.

Unlike many of the CDs I buy and hear these days, this one will get many repeated playings in my house! I hope you feel the same. Congratulations, all of you UNI cats!
