Jazz has been a vital part of UNI for over 30 years. Today, our jazz program is known and respected nationwide. Performing groups include four jazz bands, several small jazz combos, a Dixieland band, the Faculty Jazz Quintet, and a studio orchestra lab. Courses in jazz studies include Jazz Theory, Beginning Jazz Improvisation, Advanced Jazz Improvisation, Jazz Arranging (I-II), Jazz History and Styles, Jazz Ensemble Techniques, and Jazz/Pop Literature. A jazz emphasis is available with the bachelor of music degree and a jazz studies minor is offered with the bachelor of arts in music degree.

Jazz Band I maintains a balance between traditional and progressive big band jazz, with emphasis on student compositions and arrangements. The band is a consistent winner in college jazz festivals and has appeared at two NAJE conventions (1978 and 1982). Recent guest performers include Marvin Stamm, Jim McNeely, Lanny Morgan, David Liebman, Bruce Forman, JoAnne Brackeen and Bobby Shew.
